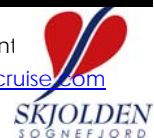

#### Harbour fees + quay fees

<b>Per gross ton</b>	<b>NOK</b>
For the first 5000 t	1,20
For the next 5 000 t	0,90
Everything over 10 000 t	0,80

#### Mooring fee

Vessels that come into the harbour are themselves responsible for ensuring that their mooring is secure. In conjunction with the declaration of arrival/ordering of a quay or anchor place, but all necessary assistance in securing mooring may be requisitioned from the harbour office when booking of berth position is taking place or minimum 3 days before arrival, upon the payment of the following tariffs:

For the first 5000	0,45
For the next 5 000	0,35
Everything over 10 000	0,25

#### Safety / ISPS fees

After implantation of the ISPS-code all vessels need to pay for security and guard service after the actual cost, a price which covers the Coast Guards fee, the investment cost and one that covers the security staff. The Cruise Line Company / Cruise ship can organize own guards at the berth, but this has to be notified and confirmed to the local authority when booking of berth position is taking place. Otherwise the port authority will provide and bill for security staff according to the ISPS – code.

For ships at anchor only

Passenger fee + tender quay fee

25 NOK per passenger on board the ship (please note that this includes harbour fee and access to the tender pier).
